Holmes Chapel Show at HC Community Centre

Rules

- All exhibitors must complete an entry form and send to HC Partnership – Show, 31 Alumbrook Ave, Holmes Chapel CW4 7BX to be received no later than 1 September 2018.
- Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Adult Classes 1 – 40. Young Persons, 16 years and under, Classes 41 – 49.
- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor only and made within the last two years.
- Exhibits to be staged at HC Community Centre on Sunday 16 September between 9.00am and 10.30am.
- The show organisers are the sole authority in arranging how or where exhibits are to be shown and have the right to refuse an entry.
- The judges decisions are final.
- No exhibit may be removed until 5.00pm on Sunday. Whilst every care will be taken, the organisers do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage from any cause to exhibits or containers. Exhibits will be disposed of if not collected at 5.00pm.

- Class 1 plants and/or flowers and/or vegetables
- Class 2 portrait or figure composition
- Class 3 landscape-urban or rural

CREATIVE HOBBY

- Class 4 a handmade greeting card
- Class 5 a knitted item
- Class 6 an item of jewellery
- Class 7 an item of papercraft
- Class 8 an item of woodwork
- Class 9 an item of needlework

FLORAL ART

- Class 10 Colour fantasia – an exhibit Space allowed 60cm
- Class 11 My beautiful basket – space allowed 40cm
- Class 12 small is beautiful – an exhibit not exceeding 25cm in width and 25cm in depth, height unlimited

HORTICULTURE

- Class 13 5 runner beans
- Class 14 5 potatoes – any variety
- Class 15 plate of 5 tomatoes
- Class 16 3 onions -any variety
- Class 17 a collection of herbs – named
- Class 18 5 apples
- Class 19 any other vegetable not specified above
- Class 20 a display of a collection of 4 kinds of vegetables, 3 of each kind
- Class 21 5 stems of flowers in a vase, at least 3 different varieties
- Class 22 1 specimen rose
- Class 23 1 flowering plant
- Class 24 1 foliage plant
- Class 24a 1 cactus / succulent

PRODUCE

- Class 25 lemon drizzle cake
- Class 26 tea loaf
- Class 27 plate of 5 assorted biscuits
- Class 28 decorated sandwich cake
- Class 29 plate of 5 cup cakes
- Class 30 plate of 5 savoury scones
- Class 31 plate of 5 sweet scones
- Class 32 savoury flan
- Class 33 a loaf of bread, handmade
- Class 34 jar of jam

Exhibits to be 13cm x 18 cm. No mounts.
Photographs should be printed on photographic paper and may be colour or black and white.

YOUNG PERSON CATEGORIES- under the age of 16 years

Your age should be displayed on or near your exhibit. The entry must be your own unaided work.

COOKERY

To be displayed on a plate

- Class 41 my favourite tray bake – 5 pieces
- Class 42 my favourite cup cakes –5 decorated same or assorted
- Class 43 savoury pizza decorated as a face (a bought pizza base may be used)

CREATIVE TOPICS

- Class 44 a lego or duplo model with title – an exhibit not exceeding 30cm in width and 30cm in depth, height unlimited.
- Class 45 an original poem hand written on A4 paper – decorative border allowed
- Class 46 any other creative topic made by you- an exhibit not exceeding display space of 30cm x 30cm
- Class 47 a selfie photograph with a Holmes Chapel scene as the background – size 13cm x 18cm. Photograph should be printed on photographic paper and may be colour or black and white

PAINTING

No larger than A4 and mounted on a slightly larger sheet of paper or card.

- Class 48 a painting of your friend
- Class 49 a painting of any scene/ subject in Holmes Chapel village
